## Suicide

They run a 24/7 crisis line and can mobilize a team to come transport the student to a mental health facility. If they would like to talk to someone and are NOT in immediate danger they can call the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline 1 (800) 273-8255.

## Mental Health/Substance Abuse

For mental health, substance abuse issues you can contact **Partners Behavioral Health 1** (888) 235-4673. They will speak to the student, assess the urgency and set up the first appointment with a counselor. The first appointment will be within 14 days. This service is intended for those with no insurance or with Medicaid. This is just a good referral line even if you are unsure of the student's insurance situation. Generally, if they have insurance they will see who the insurance plan dictates. Here in Iredell County that are many options for them to choose from just depending on their need, location, etc.
