The housing choice voucher program is the federal government's major program for assisting very low-income families, the elderly, and the disabled to afford decent, safe, and sanitary housing in the private market. Since housing assistance is provided on behalf of the family or individual, participants are able to find their own housing, including single-family homes, townhouses and apartments.

Eligibility for a housing voucher is based on the total annual gross income and family size and is limited to US citizens and specified categories of non-citizens who have eligible immigration status. In general, the family's income may not exceed 50% of the median income for the county or metropolitan area in which the family chooses to live. By law, a PHA (public housing agency) must provide 75 percent of its voucher to applicants whose incomes do not exceed 30 percent of the area median income. Median income levels are published by HUD and vary by location. The PHA serving your community can provide you with the income limits for your area and family size. <https://www.gosect8.com>

Requirements for unemployment benefits are: you must be unemployed due to no fault of your own, must be monetarily eligible, and available and actively seeking work

What an individual needs in order to apply:

- social security number
- details from your most recent employer about separation, vacation or severance pay you received, will receive, or are entitled to receive.
- details regarding any retirement pay (gross monthly amount of pay along with proof).
- your bank routing number and account number if you would like unemployment payments directly deposited into your bank account. If you do not select direct deposit, payment will be placed on a DES issued debit card.
- your work history for the past two years (employer name as it appears on your check stub, employer's payroll and physical addresses, telephone number, employment dates, rate of pay and reason for separation from each employer.)

Food and Nutrition Services is a federal food assistance program that provides low-income families the food they need for a nutritionally adequate diet. Benefits are issued via Electronic Benefit Transfer cards (EBT cards). There are three ways to apply for Food and Nutrition Services (Food Stamps):

1. Apply online with ePass. www.ncdhhs.gov
2. Apply in person at your county Department of Social Services (DSS) office. It helps to fill out as much of the application as possible ahead of time.
3. Fill out a paper application and mail to or drop it off at your county DSS office.

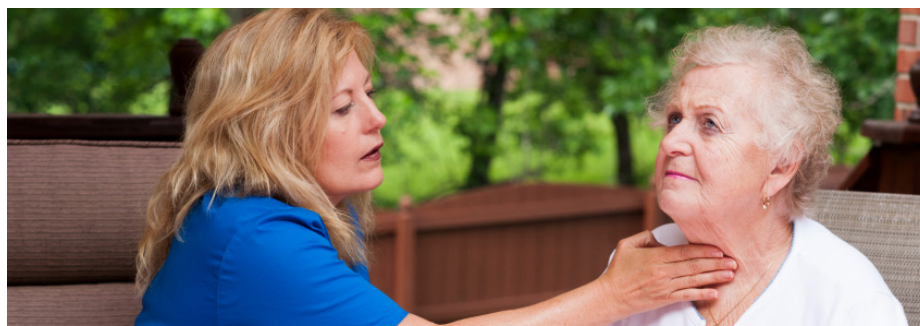

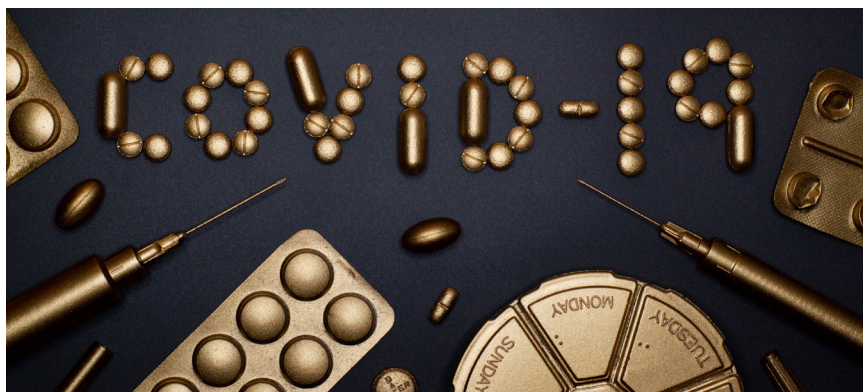

Requirements for unemployment benefits are: you must be unemployed due to no fault of your own, must be monetarily eligible, and available and actively seeking work (*this has been waived temporarily due to COVID-19*)

What an individual needs in order to apply:

- social security number
- details from your most recent employer about separation, vacation or severance pay you received, will receive, or are entitled to receive.
- details regarding any retirement pay (gross monthly amount of pay along with proof).
- your bank routing number and account number if you would like unemployment payments directly deposited into your bank account. If you do not select direct deposit, payment will be placed on a DES issued debit card.
- your work history for the past two years (employer name as it appears on your check stub, employer's payroll and physical addresses, telephone number, employment dates, rate of pay and reason for separation from each employer).

Since the COVID-19 virus has emerged, the quickest and easiest way to apply is online due to the high call volume. The site shuts down from 11 p.m.-3 a.m. for maintenance in order to help accommodate people because of higher site traffic during the day. Due to COVID-19, the requirement for searching for work is waived.
